Changes to the agenda

Discussed how Adirondack Curriculum Project would restructure. Agreed to convene the Steering Committee to bring them up-to-date on what was happening, recruit new board members and get their recommendations on reorganizing. Board agreed to do this as part of the annual meeting on June 3rd.

Mr. Drury shared information about the upcoming meeting regarding the Forest Preserve education Program and a conference he had attended "Collaborative for the Study of Adirondack Cultural Heritage"
